

# AEG Member Receives Award

**D**r. Donald Bruce, President of Geosystems, L.P. in Pittsburgh, PA, was recently awarded the "Wallace Hayward Baker Award" by the Geo-Institute of the American Society of Civil Engineers. This award was established in the year 2000 in recognition of the creative and innovative contributions of Dr. Baker in the field of ground modification. In Donald's case, the citation on the award reads, "For your dedication, enrichment and advancement of geotechnology related to ground modification, reinforcement and improvement."

The award was presented during the conference held by the Geo-Institute and the Association of Drilled Shaft Contractors (International Association of Foundation Drilling) in Orlando, Florida, in January, 2004.

Dr. Bruce studied in Aberdeen, Scotland, before working for specialty geotechnical contractors worldwide. Since 1996, he has run his own firm of consultants and is active in many national and international committees dealing with various practical aspects of geotechnology.
